





- Statutorily authorizes access to specialized services outside of child serving systems but lacks a formal coordination mechanism
- Mandates the development of a plan for coordinating access to specialized, community-based services
- No statutory access to a coordinated, community-based service response

- Funding appropriated to support specialized, community-based service providers
- In Maine, access is statutorily limited to children identified as homeless youth or as runaways
