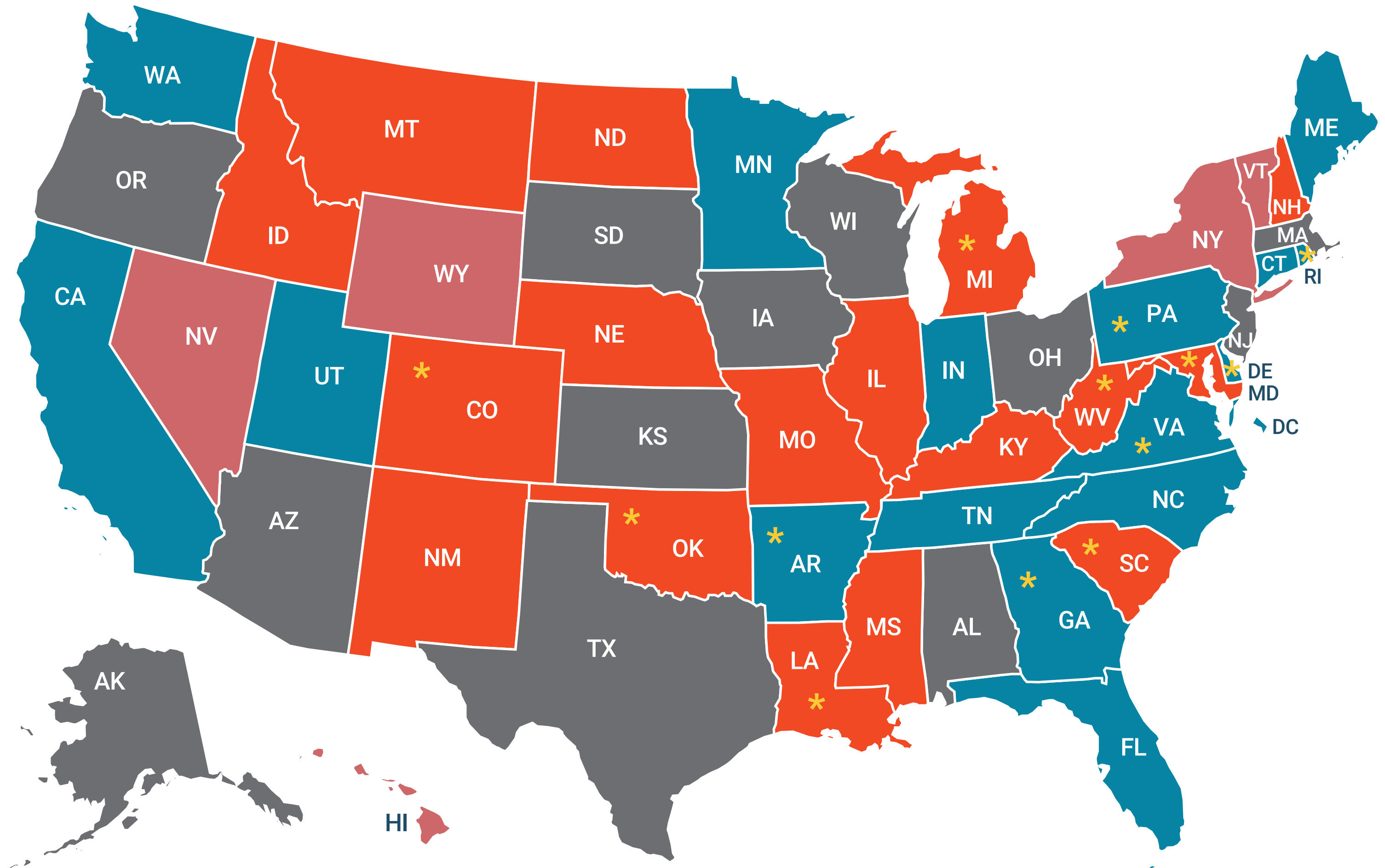


Non-Criminalization Laws



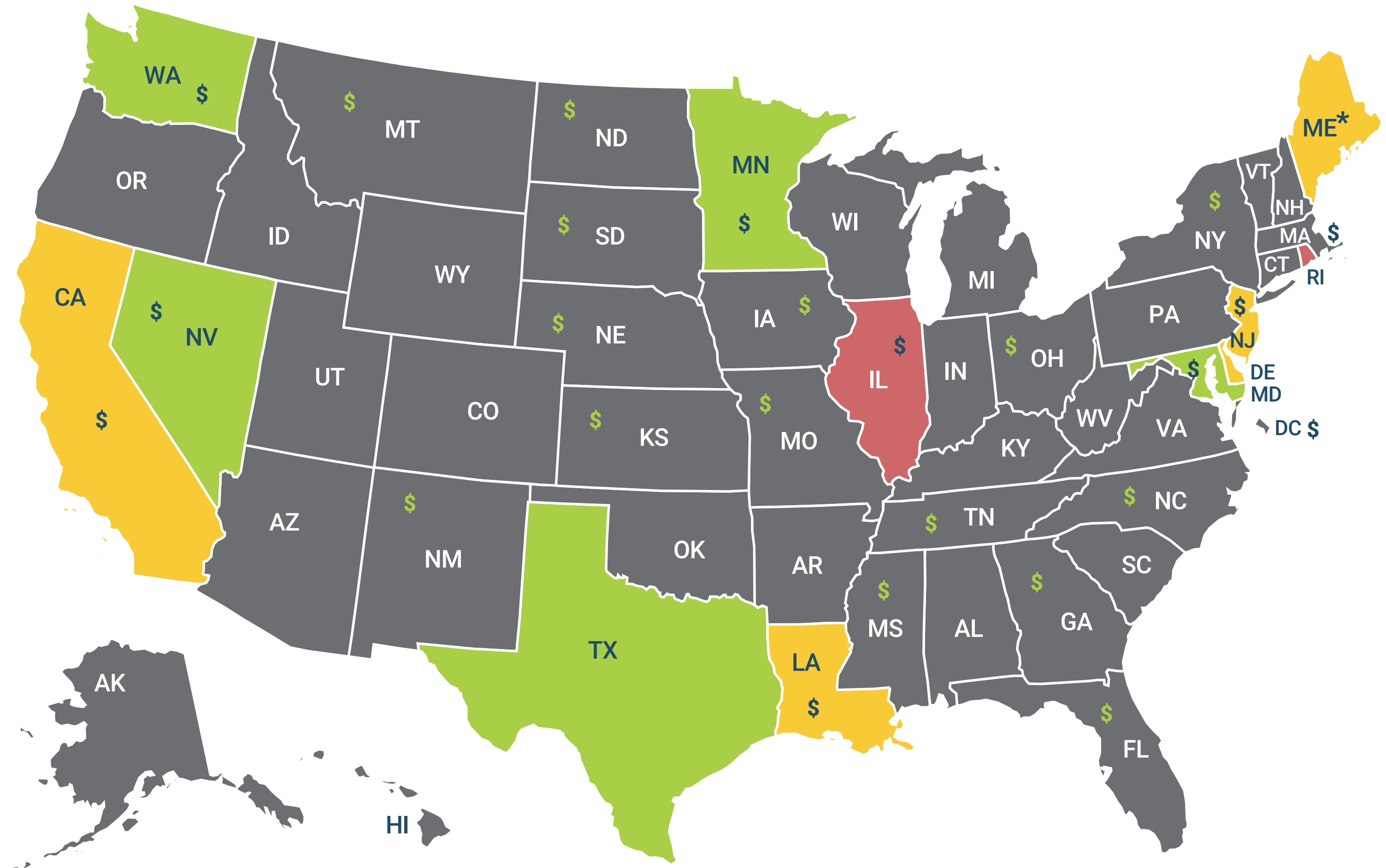
Map Legend

33 states + D.C. have Safe Harbor laws that, at a minimum, prohibit the criminalization of child sex trafficking victims for prostitution offenses.

22 states prohibit the criminalization of child sex trafficking victims for offenses other than prostitution.

Coordinating Community-Based Service Responses



Map Legend

- Statutorily establishes a coordinated, community-based service response outside of child-serving systems
- Statutorily authorizes access to specialized services outside of child serving systems but lack a formal coordination mechanism
- Mandates the development of a plan for coordinating access to specialized, community-based services
- No statutory access to a coordinated, community-based service response
- \$ Funding appropriated to support specialized, community-based service providers
- ★ In Maine, access is statutorily limited to children identified as homeless youth or as runaways
